Wiring Accessories



The National Electrical Code requirements for fluorescent fixtures will change on January 01, 2008: the **installer** must include a disconnect for each luminaire* that includes double ended fluorescent lamps.

Texas Fluorescents offers our entire commercial and industrial fluorescent line with ballast disconnects.

Append the letter : “**D**” to our standard part numbers to include a disconnect.

131 A 432 E120, 2x4 4 lamp troffer with 120V generic electronic becomes

131 A 432 E120 **D** to include a disconnect.

The Cost for this adder is \$1.00 per ballast.

*The NEC does provide exceptions to the disconnect requirements, including:

Dwellings, and associated structures

Hazardous locations

Some fixtures that provide emergency illumination, and

Industrial applications with restricted access and supervision that ensure only qualified persons service luminaires according to written procedures.

Other exceptions may apply. We refer installers directly to the National Electric Code and local electrical codes for your area.

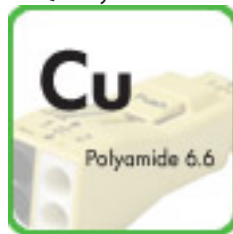

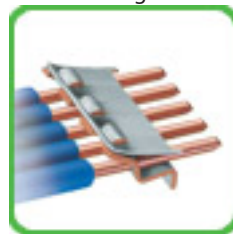
